Boise, Idaho, December 31, 1918.

His Excellency M. ALEXANDER, Governor, State of Idaho, Boise, Idaho.

Sir:

As provided by law I beg to submit herewith the Fourteenth Annual Report of the State Banking Department covering the year 1918, which contains the following schedules:

- 1. Comparative statements.
- 2. Receipts and expenditures for the year and biennial appropriation.
- Banks chartered, nationalized, increasing capital stock, changing name, changing location.
- 4. List of State Bank members of the Federal Reserve System.
- Reports of condition of banks under the supervision of this Department, numbering 121 State Banks, 12 Bank & Trust Companies, 3 Private Banks, 1 Savings Bank, making a total of 137 as shown by call report under date of November 1, 1918.

In reviewing financial conditions during the past year, it is hardly necessary to say that the year has been a very strenuous one. The people of Idaho have been called upon by the Government for financial assistance in the various war drives, and it is gratifying to know that the banks of Idaho and everyone rallied to this support in a way that is deserving of the highest praise and it is my desire that in this report all of the banks should receive this recognized praise.

It will be noted in the comparative statement that deposits of the State Banks as shown in this report are over three million dollars less than in the report for 1917. This is accounted for by reason of the fact that the report for 1917 was made for close of business as of November 20th, while the call for 1918 is made for close of business as of November 1st. The twenty days intervening consequently makes it impossible to show a fair comparison as the first twenty days in November are the very best twenty days in the year and undoubtedly if the call this year had been made on November 20th, deposits would have shown an increase A further comparison shows that total resources of State Banks increased over one million dollars. The average reserve of the banks is well above the legal requirement showing that our banking institutions are all in a strong position.

There are now twenty-seven State Bank members of the Federal Reserve system in Idaho and during the year twenty-five of these have been admitted. We feel proud of the fact, and it is interesting to know that there is only one other state in the Twelfth Federal Reserve District having more State Bank members than Idaho, and that state exceeds us by only one bank.

We are pleased to state that for over four years there have been no bank failures in Idaho.

In conclusion, we want to take this means of extending our hearty thanks and appreciation to the bankers of Idaho for their cooperation with this Depart-

ment during the past four years.
