## 2009 Idaho Conference on Housing Idaho Department of Finance Offers Information about Mortgage Industry

Speakers at the two-day conference will include keynote speaker Lawrence Yun, national economist, as well as Mike Ferguson, Idaho's Chief Economist. In addition, the conference will provide informative workshops on a variety of housing issues. Workshop speakers will include, among others, the mayors of Eagle, Nampa, Meridian, and Idaho Falls, Idaho.
