Comes now the plaintiff, by and through counsel, and the defendant John F. Corbin, by and through counsel, in order to avoid prolonged litigation, to stipulate and agree as follows:

I.

The defendant John F. Corbin enters his appearance in this action and submits itself to the jurisdiction of the aboveentitled Court.

STIPULATION FOR JUDGMENT AND PERMANENT INJUNCTION - 1 The plaintiff has authority to bring this action; this Court has jurisdiction over the subject matter of this action and over the parties hereto; and, the complaint on file herein states a cause of action for injunctive relief against the stipulating defendant.

III.

The defendant John F. Corbin admits violating Idaho Code §30-1406 as alleged in the complaint herein.

IV.

The defendant John F. Corbin agrees that the Judgment and Permanent Injunction attached hereto may be entered against him and he hereby consents to the entry thereof.

v.

Said Judgment and Permanent Injunction shall constitute a final resolution of all issues presented in plaintiff's complaint as to defendant John F. Corbin, and may be presented to the Court immediately or at any time convenient to the Court, without the necessity of findings of fact or conclusions of law or further pleadings or proceedings in this matter.

VI.

The defendant John F. Corbin agrees that a civil penalty in the amount of three thousand dollars (\$3,000) shall be assessed against him, and shall be paid within thirty (30) days of the date of the Judgment in this matter.
