




3. The Defendants agree that the Judgment and Permanent Injunction attached hereto may be entered against them and hereby consent to the entry thereof.

Said Judgment and Permanent Injunction shall constitute a final resolution of all issues presented in or which could have been presented in Plaintiff's Complaint as to the Defendants, and may be presented to the Court immediately or at any time convenient to the Court, without the necessity of findings of fact or conclusions of law or further pleadings or proceedings in this matter. This Judgment and Permanent Injunction shall serve as a final resolution of all issues presented in or which could have been presented in Plaintiff's Complaint.

5. Plaintiff agrees that it will seek no further remedies.


6. All stipulating parties shall bear their own attorneys' fees and costs of litigation.


