I.

The defendant Moller enters his appearance in this action and submits himself to the jurisdiction of the above-entitled Court.

II.

The plaintiff has authority to bring this action; this Court has jurisdiction over the subject matter of this action and over the parties hereto; and, the complaint on file herein states a

The defendant Moller agrees that the Judgment and Permanent Injunction attached hereto may be entered against him and he hereby consents to the entry thereof.

Said Judgment and Permanent Injunction shall constitute a final resolution of all issues presented in plaintiff's complaint as to defendant Moller, and may be presented to the Court immediately or at any time convenient to the Court, without the necessity of findings of fact or conclusions of law or further pleadings or proceedings in this matter.

VI.

All stipulating parties shall bear their own attorney's fees and costs of litigation.
