**JUDGMENT AND PERMANENT
INJUNCTION AGAINST
DEFENDANTS JAY L. WILCOX,
MARLIS KIM HARRIS, AND
TONY SELLERS**

On February 14, 2000, Judge D. Duff McKee entered an Order and Temporary Injunction (Order) in this action, granting the State's motion for partial summary judgment against Defendants Jay L. Wilcox (Wilcox), Marlis Kim Harris (Harris) and Tony Sellers (Sellers) as to Count One of the AMENDED COMPLAINT filed on May 27, 1998 in this action, and granting

the State's motion for partial summary judgment against Defendant Sellers as to Count Two of the AMENDED COMPLAINT. The Order also entered temporary injunctions against Defendants Wilcox, Harris, and Sellers.

Now, pursuant to such Order, THE COURT HEREBY FINDS, as a matter of law, as follows:

1. Defendants Wilcox, Harris, and Sellers sold or offered for sale, or caused to be sold, either directly or indirectly, or aided and abetted in the offer or sale of, notes, evidences of indebtedness, and/or investment contract securities, which securities were not registered with the Idaho Department of Finance, in violation of Idaho Code § 30-1416.

2. Defendant Sellers at no time was licensed with the Idaho Department of Finance as a broker-dealer or salesman to sell or offer for sale securities in Idaho. Defendant Sellers' acts of selling, offering for sale, or causing to be sold, either directly or indirectly, or aiding and abetting in the offer or sale of notes, evidences of indebtedness, and/or investment contract securities, while unlicensed with the Idaho Department of Finance, constituted a violation of Idaho Code § 30-1406.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Court hereby ORDERS, ADJUDGES, AND DECREES as follows:

INJUNCTIVE RELIEF:

Defendants Wilcox, Harris, and Sellers are permanently enjoined from offering for sale in Idaho investments in PCO, Inc., aka Personal Choice Opportunities.

Defendant Sellers is permanently enjoined from transacting securities business in Idaho while not registered as a securities sales in accordance with Title 30, Chapter 14, Idaho, and its

successor act, the Uniform Securities Act (2004), Idaho Code § 30-14-101, *et seq.*
