**JUDGMENT OF
PERMANENT INJUNCTION**

The Plaintiff, State of Idaho, Department of Finance, having moved for summary judgment against the Defendant, Louise Martinez Schneider, on the first four counts of its complaint, and the Court having issued a Decision and Order granting the Plaintiff's motion for summary judgment, and the Court having issued an Order denying the Defendant's motions, filed July 3,

1997 and August 15, 1997, to alter or amend,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that:

1. The Defendant Louise Martinez Schneider has violated the Idaho Securities Act, specifically Idaho Code §§ 30-1403(2) and (3), 30-1406, and 30-1416.

2. The Defendant Louise Martinez Schneider is permanently enjoined from engaging in any acts, practices or omissions which would constitute violations of the Idaho Securities Act, and in particular, is permanently enjoined from:

A. Transacting securities business in the State of Idaho until such time as Defendant has registered as a salesperson with the Idaho Department of Finance, in accordance with Title 30, Chapter 14, Idaho Code;

B. Selling or offering for sale nonexempt securities in any form in the State of Idaho until such time as such securities have been registered with the Idaho Department of Finance, in accordance with Title 30, Chapter 14, Idaho Code;

C. In connection with the offer, sale, or purchase of any security:

(1) Making any untrue statement of material fact, or omitting to state a material fact necessary in order to make the statements made, in the light of the circumstances under which they are made, not misleading; and

(2) Engaging in any act, practice or course of business which operates or would operate as a fraud or deceit upon any person.


D. Aiding, abetting, counseling, inducing or causing any other person to engage in any of the types of conduct described in paragraphs A, B, and C above.

3. The Defendant Louise Martinez Schneider is prohibited from claiming the availability of, using, or offering to sell securities under, any exemption under the Idaho Securities

Act without receiving the prior written consent of the Director.
